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WHAT IS IMAGINE NATIONS CHURCH INTERNSHIP?

Grow in life experience.

Serve the high calling of God.

Discover God's will and purpose.

Internship will give you the experience of serving in the day-to-day life of Imagine Nations Church, whilst studying a Certification of Local Church Ministry.

Internship consists of:

- Serving in one Sunday Service every week and attending one Service every week
- A full Study Day on Tuesday and another full Ministry Day would be negotiated with your Ministry Pastor
- Interns are involved in serving at all events hosted by Imagine Nations Church. The annual events include: Imagine Nations Conference, Easter Services & Events, Choctoberfest and the Christmas Event
- Other dates include Ministry Specific Conferences throughout the year, dependant on your chosen ministry area
- Weekly Staff Devotions
- Mentor Meetings
- Certificate Study groups
- Team focus specific work, projects & event requirements
- Attendance to conferences & training days
- Serving at the ACC NSW State Conference

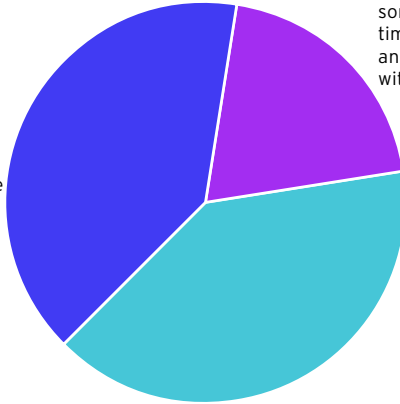
You will be discipled by great leaders, discovering your spiritual gifts and developing your Christian character all whilst completing your Certification of Local Church Ministry.

While Interns will serve primarily in one ministry area, you will be exposed to a broad range of ministries and experiences.

Your Active Year

40% of your time is invested into the Ministry Area

This is your chosen Ministry Area where you will have the opportunity to complete team assignments and tasks while gaining valuable ministry experience.



20% Certificate Study

Through study sessions and some extra personal study time you are able to discuss and process your studies with others.

40% of your time is invested into other Internship Modules

This includes a variety of Sunday serving areas; staff, mentor and training meetings; events and trips. Here you will gain a specialised behind the scenes experience.

Dates

Internship 2024 begins on January 30th through to December 22nd with a special graduation dinner in December.

Cost

Internship cost for the year is \$2,500

The break-up of these costs are:

- A \$500 Deposit to be paid upon Internship acceptance, by mid-January, 2024
- 4 instalments of \$500 to be paid before the start of each term (End of January, April, July & October)

You will be provided with an invoice at the start of each term with ways to pay. If necessary, payment plans can be negotiated.

MINISTRY AREAS

Kids & Scripture

Kids Internship is for those who have a love for children and a passion to grow in their ability to minister to children. You will be involved in Sunday services as well as scripture in schools during the week. You will assist with administration and pastoral care as well as and planning and serving with INK events such as Choctoberfest and Easter Family Fun day and church conferences. You may also be involved in creative staging and mentoring of young team depending on your gifting and experience.

Youth & Highschools

Youth Interns work directly with the Youth Pastors and young people with the goal to support them through one of the most exciting stages of life: the teenage years! Our Friday Nights, Youth CGs and High School outreach ministries will be blessed by your ideas, energy and passion for young people. You will become a key member of our Youth Team, while also working directly in local high schools through our Scripture program. Young people are ready to be shaped and we're ready to have you join our team if this blurb excites you!

Outreach

Do you want to see non-Christians turned into totally committed followers of Jesus?

Being part of this team you will gain important project management and people skills. You will have the opportunity to reach out to our community and share the gospel through various outreaches including Alpha. You will learn how to help people connect in to church, and guide people taking their next steps on their journey with Jesus. You will go to a new level learning to lead the team that makes our Sunday services so welcoming.

Worship & Creative

Our Creative Team is responsible for inspiring and designing the 'look and feel' of our church. This includes song selection, song writing, song recording, song editing, sound mixing, event branding, advertising, multimedia, stage and lighting designs, team development and more. This also includes mobilising and working with our volunteer INCreative team to see creative ideas executed well.

What is Certification?

Axx certification is a formal recognition that you have met all the requirements of a course, qualification or program of study. It ensures that you have the skills and knowledge required to perform a variety of ministry functions. It serves as an official recognition that you have attained qualifications and expertise in core areas of the Ministry, Bible and Theology.

Axx Explained - Academic Levels

Certificate - This is an introductory qualification suitable for new or mature believers who are seeking systematic teaching presented in a clear and uncomplicated manner.

Certification - This is a ministry preparatory qualification which is highly structure and tailored to meet specific needs. These courses are taught at a diploma academic level.

Advanced Certification - This is a more advanced ministry qualification that builds on knowledge and skills developed at the Certification level. These qualifications are taught at an advanced diploma or entry BA degree level.

Licentiate - This is a higher academic qualification design for people who are seeking to enter or progress into ministry full-time. These qualifications are taught at upper degree and postgraduate level.

MasterClass - These qualifications are for ministry professionals who are seeking to stretch and challenge themselves, their ministry and biblical expertise. These qualifications are taught at the Masters and Doctorate levels.

How is the course delivered?

The course is delivered online with video and questions, plus small discussion groups.

When do I study?

Tuesday is a study day where you will view your course videos and complete reading and the required questionnaires. You will also have group discussions about your course content.

Is there any extra support while I am studying?

Your Internship pastor, Ministry Pastor and Mentors are all available to support you if necessary. Internship is an adult learning environment, and self-discipline and personal organisation are a requisite of such learning.

COURSE UNITS

Core Internship Study: Certification of Local Church Ministry

- **Introduction to the Biblical Narrative**

- How to understand & communicate the Bible's key themes, events, characters and how to apply lessons learnt in my life and ministry.

- **Analyse & Apply the Bible**

- How to master the features of a study Bible, to interpret what a biblical passage meant to its original audience and how to apply learnt principles to my life, family and ministry community.

- **Personal Management and Spiritual Health**

- How to develop your relationship with God through holistic spiritual and practical disciplines to achieve your God-given destiny and spiritual goals.

- **Theology of God**

- How to grasp the true nature of God revealed in the Father, Jesus & the Holy Spirit. You will also learn how to assess personal needs and grow in the gifts and fruit of the Spirit.

- **Group Ministry Practice**

- How to serve, lead and develop your ministry team in a local church or another ministry context. Your role and responsibilities are made more effective and measured against best practice and biblical standards. Ministry practices are recommended to increase ministry health and effectiveness in light of church/ministry focus.

- **Work with and Care for Others**

- How to provide pastoral care for an individual, members of a family or your community. How to effectively work with and serve people whilst developing tools and insights in self-awareness. You will understand how to apply principles and skills to promote effective group harmony and synergy.

Elective certificate options:

Leadership

Make a difference and build your leadership. This Certificate of Biblical Leadership Course is ideally suited for people who want to be biblical influencers in all spheres of life, ministry and career.

- **Personal Spiritual Growth**

- How to lay a personal foundation for development as a Christian and a leader through a process of personal and spiritual growth, thus undergirding all their spiritual life and ministry.

- **Authentic Leadership**

- How to be equipped with the skills and knowledge required to lead others effectively in a manner that is shaped by a Christian understanding of leadership.

- **Foundations of Leadership**

- How to manage conflict, leading collaboratively, failure, risk and decisions before the course moves into implementing and sustaining change. The foundational principles of leadership in ministry and work.

Pastoral care

The Certificate of Pastoral Care is a biblical approach to caring for people in the community, local church or ministry context. In addition, you will learn when to refer people in your care to professional counsellors or more experienced pastors.

- **Pastoral Care**

- How to care for people pastorally. You will be provided with the tools and teaching to work within a good pastoral care team.

- **Counselling Basics: Part 1**

- The introductory skills and knowledge required to establish and apply a biblical Christian counselling approach. You will also learn about mental illness and depression in relation to understanding and renewing the mind.

- **Counselling Basics: Part 2**

- The theology of emotions and the emotions that are encountered in counselling and life including; anger, anxiety, grief & loss, guilt & shame and conflict. You will then learn about forgiveness, inner healing, prayer and pastoral counselling.

Bible

This certificate is the perfect starting point for a deeper appreciation of the Bible. The Certificate of the Bible is a structured program of study that guides the learner through the basics of Understanding and Interpreting the Old and the New Testaments.

- **Introduction to the Biblical Narrative**

- How to understand & communicate the Bible's key themes, events, characters and how to apply lessons learnt in my life and ministry.

- **Analyse & Apply the Bible**

- How to master the features of a study Bible, to interpret what a biblical passage meant to its original audience and how to apply learnt principles to my life, family and ministry community.

- **Our Place in Gods Narrative**

- You will learn about the big picture - God, Us & You and finding your place in God's Mission. God among people & affecting earth through the preaching of the kingdom. You will be challenged to be involved in the Plan, not just on-lookers.

Justice, Poverty & Development

The Certificate of Justice Poverty and Development prepares you to make a real difference in the world we live in. It engages issues such as justice, poverty, aid & development.

- **Social & Environmental Justice**

- This course describes the skills and knowledge necessary to develop an appropriate response to contemporary justice issues inherent to Christian ministry.

- **Poverty, Aid & Development**

- Learn biblical solutions to an ancient and current problem. Learn how to facilitate poverty alleviating measures on a local and global scale. Learn what is poverty and what are its causes and what are its results?

- **NGO Practice**

- Learn how to equip believers with the skills and knowledge required to evaluate efforts to deal with poverty, participate in aid and development and advocate for the aid and development cause from biblical and experiential perspectives.

Kids' Ministry

Youth Ministry

The Certificate of Youth Ministry helps you understand how to engage youth culture and how to minister to young people inside the Church and in your community.

- **Youth Ministry 1 - Part 1**

- How to understand youth culture and apply it to youth ministry in a local Church. Then use those skills to reach out to young people in the community.

- **Youth Ministry 1 - Part 2**

- To develop yourself as a leader and develop the leadership skills of those around you in your youth ministry.

- **Youth Ministry 2 - Part 1**

- How to understand the changing society and the impact those changes have on communicating with youth when you are competing for their attention.

- **Youth Ministry 2 - Part 2**

- To reflect & adapt to changes to grow a successful ministry, including junior youth, high school youth & young adults. Building the skills needed by youth leaders to minister in a local church.

- **Concepts for Youth Ministry**

- Learn valuable drivers for effective youth ministry including; purpose, small groups, events, transitions and health indicators.
